By filing the present petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought regular bail in FIR No.219 dated 28.06.2015, registered under Sections 148, 323, 341, 307, 120-B read with Section 149 of IPC, at Police Station Beri, District Jhajjar.

It is contended that no specific injury has been attributed to the petitioner. In fact, the main injuries have been attributed to co-accused Om Parkash and Sarang. The petitioner is in custody since 03.07.2015.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel as well as

the learned counsel for the complainant oppose the bail application and states that the petitioner along with co-accused caused injuries to the complainant and his wife due to existing hostility between the parties.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

During the course of investigation, a report with regard to health status of the injured Sajjan Singh was obtained from PGIMS, Rohtak. As per report, the injury is of the same duration relatable to the incident. The injured had slipped into coma on receipt of injury. Though the injured has been discharged from the hospital, however, he is still disoriented to the state of mind. Considering the above, no case for grant of relief sought, is made out.

Dismissed.

Anything said herein above shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.

However, considering the fact that the trial is not progressing at the required pace, the trial Court is directed to conclude the trial expeditiously.
