FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

Report dated 09.05.2017 sent by learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class Amritsar has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Parambir Singh @ Bir, Ranjit Singh, Happy @ Amarbir Singh as well as of complainant Baljinder Singh it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that parties have effected a compromise for the offences which are not of heinous nature and which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543 and Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab

and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052, FIR No.81 dated 01.05.2014 under Sections 341, 295,506,148,149 323, IPC, Police Station, Sadar, Amritsar and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioners.
