Through this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, prayer has been made for quashing F.I.R. No.54 dated 07.06.2010 registered under Sections 323, 324, 452, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Sadar Kapurthala, on the basis of compromise dated 24.04.2017 (Annexure-P2).

Vide orders dated 07.10.2017 and 01.11.2017 passed by this Court, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate, for recording their statements qua compromise with a direction to the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate to furnish a report regarding veracity thereof, if any, between the parties.

Consequently, the parties had appeared before the Additional

Chief Judicial Magistrate, Kapurthala, on 13.10.2017 and 15.11.2017 and

got recorded their statements. Reports from the concerned Magistrate have been received vide letter No.3433 dated 01.11.2017 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Kapurthala vide Endst. No.1769/AG1 dated 01.11.2017 and letter No.3720 dated 01.12.2017.

According to the reports of Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Kapurthala, the compromise has been effected between the parties and the statements made before the court appear to be made voluntarily and without any pressure.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, the present petition is accepted and the aforesaid F.I.R. No.54 is quashed qua the petitioners, subject to depositing costs of ₹10,000/- by the petitioners with the Punjab Legal Services Authority, Chandigarh within one week.

The Registry is directed to report whether the cost is deposited by the petitioners or not.
