Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for
directions to respondent nos.2 and 3 i.e. Commissioner of Police, District
Ludhiana and Station House Officer, Police Station Meharban, District
Ludhiana to protect life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members
and further restraining respondent nos.4 to 12 from harassing them and their
family members, who are not allowing the petitioners to construct the
memorial on the land owned and possessed by him in the memory of his son
namely Sukhwinder Singh who was declared as Martyr by the State

Government. It is stated that the private respondents have demolished the memorial constructed by the petitioner and caused injuries to the petitioner, regarding which an FIR No.85 dated 24.6.2014 was registered and despite that the private respondents are not allowing the petitioner to construct the memorial.

Heard.

I am of the view that scope of Section 482 Cr.P.C. is very limited. Petitioner has produced a copy of the judgment dated 22.8.2017, passed by Civil Judge (Junior Division), Ludhiana, in which he has got the injunction order. If it is so, let the petitioner approach the same Court for execution of the said decree/ order and if he so desire. He can also produce the copy of the order before police and the police is always at liberty to take action against the offenders in accordance with law.

Present petition is disposed of accordingly.
