AMOL RATTAN SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from the police official who is present in Cour to assist him, submits that the petitioners' ages have not been found to be any different from what is given in the copies of the Aadhar cards annexed with the petition, even on query from villagers, and further, that the statements of respondents no. 4 to 7 have been recorded by the police of Police Station, Ferozepur Jhirka, to the effect that they would not interfere in the married life of the petitioners.

In view of the above, the petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous, but with a direction to respondents no. 2 and 3 to ensure that the life and liberty of the petitioners remains continued to be protected.

However, it is made clear that if any of the averments made in the petition is found to be incorrect, specifically with regard to either the petitioners

being in any prohibited relationship to each other, or as regards their previous marital status, or with regard to their age, this order shall not be construed to be a bar on proceedings initiated as per law.
