Learned State counsel has stated that the petitioners are not required by the Police in any case.

The claim of the petitioners before this Court is that they should not be harassed unnecessarily by calling them at Police Station time and again.

According to the learned State counsel, one Varinder Singh, who is a proclaimed offender is required in this case.

In view of the circumstances, the present petition is disposed of with a direction that in case Police need presence of any of the petitioners, they will not be called except by issuing notice under Section 160 Cr. P.C. stating the reasons as to why the presence is required. However, in case of women she will not be called to at any Police Station except at Women Police Station.
