Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in FIR No.53 dated 09.04.2016, under Sections 21/22/61/85 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substance Act, 1985 and Section 379(b) of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station C-Division Amritsar, District Amritsar.

Petitioner was arrested on 13.09.2016 after his surrender. He is in jail since then as under trial.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from the police official states that the contraband was not recovered from the petitioner and it was on the disclosure statement that the petitioner was participant in the crime of snatching.

In that view of the matter, this petition is allowed.
