This petition under Section 438 of the Criminal Procedure Code has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.56 dated 29.04.2013 registered under Sections 304-A, 283 and 427 of the Indian Penal Code (in short 'IPC') Police Station Kamboj, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner had been regularly appearing before the trial Court, however, he could not appear on a solitary date i.e.15.11.2016 being unwell as he remained hospitalized from 28.10.2016 to 01.11.2016. The absence of the petitioner from the process of the Court was neither intentional nor wilful.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the case file.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Ms. Harsimrat Rai, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. A complete copy of the paper book has been furnished to the learned counsel, in the Court.

In view of the above and considering the fact that the petitioner

had been regularly appearing, it is ordered that in case the petitioner surrenders before the competent Court within ten days from today, he be admitted to bail, on his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds, to its satisfaction.
