Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been made for quashing of Cross Version registered vide DDR No.35 dated 01.03.2016 under Sections 323/324/148/149 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 326 I.P.C. added subsequently in F.I.R. No.43 dated 01.03.2016 under Sections 323/ 324/ 148/ 149 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 325/ 326 I.P.C. added subsequently, pertaining to Police Station Kotwali, Kapurthala, District Kapurthala, on the basis of compromise dated 18.04.2016 (Annexure-P3).

On presentation of the petition, the parties were directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate to get their statements recorded for compromise with a direction to the Magistrate to furnish report alongwith the recorded statements qua veracity of the compromise, if any, between the

parties.

In compliance of the order dated 13.05.2016 of this Court, the parties had appeared before the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Kapurthala on 04.08.2016 and got recorded their statements for compromise and report from the concerned Magistrate has also been received vide his covering letter No.1525 dated 28.10.2016 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Kapurthala vide Endst. No.1554/AGI dated 01.11.2016.

According to the report of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Kapurthala, the parties have compromised the matter voluntarily, without any pressure or coercion through the respectable of the locality.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, the aforesaid Cross Version registered vide DDR No.35 dated 01.03.2016 in F.I.R. No.43 dated 01.03.2016, is hereby quashed.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
