Due to non-appearance of the petitioner on third occasion on 06.04.2017, bail of the petitioner was cancelled and bail bonds and surety bonds were forfeited to the State. The order was passed keeping in view the absence of the petitioner on 17.01.2017 and 29.03.2017. An application for exemption was filed before the Court on the premise that his mother had met with an accident at the first instance and thereafter, the application was filed for exemption on the pretext that he had to go Hyderabad for some urgent work. The application was not supported by any affidavit.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is ready to surrender before the trial Court.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. P.P. Chahar, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of State-respondent No.1.

In view of nature of order which this Court proposes to pass, there is no necessity to call upon respondent No.2 at this stage as the conduct of the petitioner is being deprecated by way of imposing cost of Rs.5000/-.

In the event of surrender of the petitioner before the trial Court and filing the application for bail, the same shall be considered in accordance with law on the same day subject to deposit of Rs.5000/-.

Disposed of accordingly.
