REKHA MITTAL, J.(Oral)

Vide order dated 07.01.2016 passed by this Court, the petitioners were directed to pay a sum of Rs.10,000/- as rent from January, 2016 onwards. Counsel for the petitioners has submitted that though respondent No.1 has not produced any rent receipts with regard to hiring any accommodation but the petitioners are regularly paying an amount of Rs.10,000/- per month towards rental in lieu of accommodation to the respondents from January 2016 onwards and only rent for two months is due and the same would be cleared on or before 20.02.2017.

Counsel for the parties are *ad idem* that the present petition may be disposed of and the petitioners shall continue paying an amount of Rs.10,000/- per month to the respondents in lieu of accommodation but some time-bound directions may be issued to the Court below for disposal of the main petition.

Counsel for the respondents would state that respondent No.1 has already been examined but remaining evidence is yet to be adduced. Respondent No.1 is directed to complete her evidence on or before 31.03.2017. The trial Court is directed to ensure that respondent No.1 (petitioner therein) must conclude her remaining evidence by the stipulated date. Thereafter, the petitioners (respondents therein) shall be entitled to three effective opportunities for adducing evidence. On conclusion of evidence by the respondents (petitioners herein), the trial Court shall dispose of the proceedings within a period of one month.

As this Court has not examined rival claims of the parties on merits, payment of Rs.10,000/- towards accommodation will not cause prejudice to either of the parties at the time of final disposal of the petition.

Disposed of accordingly.
