Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Sukhpal Singh, Investigating Officer contends that the petitioners have joined the investigation in compliance of the order dated 03.05.2017, passed by this Court but the recovery of the stolen items could not be effected from them.

He further contends that another FIR No.78 dated 29.04.2010 under Sections 323, 427, 354, IPC is pending against all the petitioners in which they are still at large since last seven years.

In view of the above fact that the petitioners have joined the investigation, the interim order dated 03.05.2017 passed by this Court, is made absolute. However, it is clarified that the petitioners shall re-join the investigation as and when further called by the Investigating Officer.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
