Present petition under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.4 dated 06.01.2017 under Sections 406, 420, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Dera Bassi, District SAS Nagar (Mohali).

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that as per entire case of prosecution and even the first version the alleged payment was made to Aman Kumar and Paramjit Kaur, petitioner himself was employed in the company and there was no role of the petitioner in commission of the main offence. More so, he has already joined investigation.

Learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for the complainant while affirming the fact regarding joining investigation by the petitioner contended that cheques were signed by present petitioner and payments were made to all the accused persons including petitioner Narinder Singh, so the present petition be

dismissed.

Having considered the submissions made by counsel for the parties and the fact that the petitioner has already joined investigation in this case and the primary allegations of making payment of Rs.7,15000/- are attributed to Aman Kumar and his wife Paramjit Kaur and no fruitful purpose would be served by detaining the present petitioner in custody, the present petition is accepted. In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on anticipatory bail to the satisfaction of arresting/ investigating officer, subject to the conditions provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
