LISA GILL, J.

Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 93 dated 05.08.2016 registered under Section 306 IPC at Police Station Sangat, District Bathinda.

The petitioners, who are the mother-in-law and the married sister-in-law of the deceased, have been summoned to face trial in the above said FIR on an application under Section 319 Cr.P.C. It is submitted that during investigation they were found innocent. Pursuant to order dated 04.05.2017 passed by this Court, the petitioners have appeared before the learned trial Court and they have been admitted to interim bail. The petitioners undertake to face trial and appear regularly on each and every date fixed. It is, thus, prayed that this petition be allowed.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Jagsir Singh, affirms and verifies that the petitioners have indeed appeared before the learned trial Court pursuant to order dated 04.05.2017. There are no

allegations on behalf of the State that the petitioners are likely to abscond or that they are likely to dissuade the witnesses from deposing true facts in the Court, if released on bail.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances noted above but without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, it is considered just and expedient to allow this petition. Interim bail granted to the petitioners by the learned trial Court be made absolute subject to its satisfaction.
