Petitioners-Parvinder Kumar alias Sunny and Som Pal have filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.44 dated 26.03.2017, registered at Police Station Division No.3, Jalandhar, under Sections 323, 324, 506 and 34 IPC and Section 326 IPC, added subsequently.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that petitioner No.1-Parvinder Kumar

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alias Sunny has been stated to be armed with a bat and has caused simple injury. Similarly, petitioner No.2-Som Pal has been stated to be armed with *kirpan* and has caused simple injury. Both the petitioners are not the main accused.

In pursuance of the interim order dated 04.05.2017 passed by this Court, the petitioners have already joined the investigation. They are not required for custodial interrogation. Therefore, no useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioners to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 04.05.2017, granting interim bail to the petitioners, is made absolute. However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
