This is second petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 65 dated 22.09.2014 registered under Sections 21,22,61 and 85 of NDPS Act, 1985, at Police Station Sadar Malout, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

At the very outset, learned State counsel submits that in the afore-referred FIR, the entire evidence has been concluded and the matter is now listed on 24.05.2017 before the trial Court for final arguments.

In view of the above facts, learned State counsel prays that the present petition may not be allowed at this stage.

The above fact remains uncontroverted for the reason that there is no appearance on behalf of the petitioner.

Since, in the trial, the matter is listed for 24.05.2017 for final arguments, I am not inclined to grant regular bail to the petitioner at this stage.
