The petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, in FIR No.30 dated 24.02.2016, registered under Sections 420, 494, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, at P.S. Division No.4, Ludhiana.

Heard.

On 16.05.2016, the following order was passed:-

“Counsel for the petitioner states that offence under Section 494 IPC is alleged against the petitioner, which is bailable while rest of the allegations are against the co-accused.

Learned State counsel states that he has not received the file and seeks adjournment.

Adjourned to 19.7.2016.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to

join the investigation and if she is sought to be arrested, she shall be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer subject to the conditions as envisaged in Section 438 sub Section 2 Clause (i) (ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.”

The petitioner is the alleged second wife of main accused, Vijay Mahajan, husband of the complainant herein. Vide judgment/order of even date, passed in CRM-M-15960-2016, which shall form part of this order, co-accused/husband Vijay Mahajan and complainant-wife Sonika have reached to a settlement and ad interim bail granted to the former has been made absolute.

In view of the above, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 16.05.2016, is made absolute, subject to furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.
