The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in FIR No.95 dated 02.03.2016 registered under Section 21-A/61/85 NDPS Act and 28 of the Drugs and Cosmetics Act at Police Station City Fatehabad.

Heard forthwith with consent of learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioner was arrested in this FIR on 03.03.2016 and since then he is in jail and facing the trial. Learned State counsel, on instructions from the police official, submits that by the time three witnesses have been examined and there is no other case against the petitioner of NDPS Act.

In my opinion, since the material witnesses have been examined, therefore, the petitioner should be granted concessions of bail. Hence, I make the following order:

ORDER

- (i) The CRL. MISC. No.M-15630 OF 2017 is allowed
- (ii) The petitioner be released on bail to the satisfaction of the concerned CJM/Duty Magistrate.
