The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in FIR No.01 dated 02.01.2017 registered under Sections 22 of the Narcotics Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act at Police Station Bahawala Tehsil Abohar, District Fazilka.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.
