The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 53, dated 04.04.2017, under Sections 506/34 IPC and Section 3 of the Scheduled Castes & Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, registered at Police Station Women Police Station Jhajjar, District Jhajjar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations in the FIR do not suggest that he had intentionally insulted or intimidated the complainant with intent to humiliate her. There is also no averment that the petitioner was aware of the caste of the complainant.

A Coordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated

05.05.2017 had directed the petitioner to join investigation and in the event of his arrest he should be enlarged on *ad interim* bail.

On the instructions of ASI Mukesh Kumar, the learned State counsel states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation, the interim order dated 05.05.2017 passed by this Court is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
