Learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Balraj, submits that the petitioner has since joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation and nothing is to be recovered from him and that he has no objection if the interim order is made absolute though on behalf of complainant, Mr. Verma has opposed the bail.

Since the State is not opposing the bail and culpability if any shall be determined at the time of trial, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 13.5.2016 is made absolute till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, petitioner will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

With these observations, the present petition stands disposed off.
