Learned counsel for the petitioners has informed that Vijay Kumar Malhotra-petitioner No.1 has since expired. Now, he seeks to withdraw this petition with liberty to take all the pleas qua petitioner No.2, before the trial Court.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid. However, personal appearance of petitioner No.2 before the trial Court is exempted subject to the following conditions:-

(i) She shall be represented through counsel; (ii) shall not delay/stall the trial proceedings; (iii) shall not dispute her identity as an accused: (iv) shall have no objection if, the prosecution evidence is recorded in her absence, but in the presence of her counsel; (v) shall appear before the trial Court as and when required; and (vi) any other condition which the learned trial Court may impose.
