The prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.149 dated 06.06.2016 for the offence under Sections 376, 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Focal Point, District Ludhiana City.
