This petition under Section 438 of the Criminal Procedure Code (in short Cr.P.C) has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.154 dated 29.09.2015 registered under Section 306 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Kurali, District SAS Nagar (Mohali).

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present FIR. Her name was put in column No.2 as she was found innocent by the police during investigation, but she was summoned under Section 319 Cr.P.C by the learned trial Court. The daughter of the petitioner had allegedly compelled the deceased for marriage. The occurrence had taken place at the residence of the complainant. He further contends that the petitioner is not involved in any other FIR.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Ms. Harsimrat Rai, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. A complete copy of the

paper book has been furnished to the learned counsel, in the Court.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the case file.

In view of the above, it is ordered that in case the petitioner surrenders before the competent Court within one week from today, she be admitted to bail, on her furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds, to its satisfaction.
