Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439(2) Cr.P.C. is for cancellation of bail granted to the respondent No.2 vide order dated 01.03.2017 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Ludhiana in FIR No.106 dated 29.11.2016 under Section 24 of the Immigration Act, 1983 and Section 420 IPC registered at Police Station Koom Kalan, District Ludhiana.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jasbir Singh, states that the police has completed investigation in the aforesaid FIR and the Challan has been presented in the Court. After submission of Challan, the respondent No.2-accused has been admitted on regular bail.
