Through the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in FIR No.02, dated 01.01.2014, registered under Sections 148, 149, 302, 323, 120-B IPC and Sections 25, 54 and 59 of Arms Act, at Police Station Samalkha, District Panipat.

At the very outset, learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Mukesh Kumar, submits that the entire prosecution evidence is over and, therefore, at this fag end of the trial, the petitioner be not admitted to regular bail.
