The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking bail in case FIR No.186 dated 10.12.2016 registered under Sections 304-B and 120-B IPC at Police Station Sadar Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though the death has taken place in the matrimonial house but there is no specific allegation against the petitioner. Further, there is no allegation against the petitioner with regard to demand of dowry either in the FIR or in any complaint prior to the registration of the FIR. The petitioner is in custody since 14.12.2016.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel opposes the bail application.

Heard.

Considering the fact that the petitioner is the father-in-law and there is no allegation against the petitioner with regard to demand of dowry; the challan stands already presented and; the petitioner is in custody since 14.12.2016, so, without commenting on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed. The petitioner be admitted to bail during the pendency of trial, on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/duty Magistrate concerned.
