SUDIP AHLUWALIA, J. (ORAL)

[1]. The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, 'the Cr.P.C.') seeking regular bail in case FIR No. 0013, dated March 05, 2017, registered under Sections 307/326/324/323/148/149 of the Indian Penal Code, (for short 'the I.P.C.') at Police Station Kahnuwan, District Gurdaspur.

[2]. It is submitted that actually the complainant's side was the aggressor in the occurrence. The complainant's side is alleged to have

entered the petitioner's house and indulged in violence, on account of which grievous injuries were suffered by both sides. Version of the petitioner's side has, however, not found favour with the Investigating Officer.

[3]. I need not dwell on propriety of the conclusion in this regard at this stage to the effect that injuries suffered by the petitioner, his son or other relative were all self inflicted.

[4]. Nevertheless from the Medico Legal Report of the complainant, undoubtedly there is incidence of "grievous injury". It has been further submitted on behalf of the State that the petitioner although joined the investigation, was not cooperative.

[5]. For the aforesaid reasons, the bail prayer is rejected.

[6]. Dismissed.
