Petitioners seek issuance of necessary directions to respondents No.2 and 3 for protection of their lives and personal liberties from being invaded at the hands of respondents No.4 to 6.

Ninderpal is the brother of petitioner No.1, son of petitioner No.2 and brother-in-law of petitioner No.3. FIR No.20 dated 03.02.2003 was registered against aforesaid Ninderpal for the offences under Sections 411, 382 IPC. The aforesaid Ninderpal was living in the house of his maternal uncle. In view of alleged activities of Ninderpal, he was disowned by the petitioners by way of newspaper publication dated 19.01.2013. Petitioners alleged that under the garb of alleged complicity of Ninderpal, respondents No.4 to 6 have been harassing the petitioners by way of undertaking raids and locking out their residential premises.

Precisely for the grievance in question, petitioner No.1 has submitted a representation to respondent No.2 on 01.03.2017 which is statedly pending.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Shilesh Gupta, Addl, AG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of State.

In view of nature of order which this Court proposes to pass, there is no necessity of calling upon reply.

This petition can be disposed of at this stage by directing respondent No.3 to take notice of pending representation before respondent No.2 and pass appropriate order in accordance with law. In case there is a representation before respondent No.2, a copy thereof be supplied to the office of respondent No.3 for appropriate decision in accordance with law as observed in earlier part of the order. Respondent No.3 shall not be influenced by any of the pleadings made hereinabove. He would consider the representation purely on merits.

Disposed of accordingly.
