The instant petition has been filed for quashing of the FIR No.104 dated 09.07.2013 under Sections 148/149/323/325/506 IPC, registered at Police Station Babain, District Kurukshetra and the consequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise, which has been arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the FIR is an outcome of a minor altercation between the residents of the same village and the matter has now been resolved with the intervention of panchayat.

A coordinate Bench of this Court vide an order dated 05.05.2017 had directed the trial Court to record the statements of the parties with regard to the genuineness of the compromise and send a report in this regard. The report of the trial Court dated 15.05.2017 has been received, wherein it is stated that in pursuance to the order of this Court, the statements of the parties have been recorded, which indicates that the compromise, which has been arrived at between the parties, is genuine and without any undue influence or pressure.

compromised and it would be in the interest of justice, if the FIR is quashed as no useful purpose would be served in carrying on with the prosecution.

Consequently, the petition is allowed and FIR No.104 dated 09.07.2013 under Sections 148/149/323/325/506 IPC, registered at Police Station Babain, District Kurukshetra and the consequent proceedings are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
