This petitioner has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for setting aside the order dated 06.04.2017 (Annexure P-3) passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Rewari, whereby, revision preferred by the respondent has been accepted against the summoning order dated 07.08.2015 passed by the learned JMIC, Rewari (Annexure P-2).

Petitioner has filed a complaint first before the police and subsequently before the learned Illaqa Magistrate under Section 498-A, 406, 377, 34 IPC dated 06.07.2015 (Annexure P-1) and vide order dated 07.08.2015 summoned the respondent under Section 498-A, 406 and 377 IPC while other family members were not summoned.

Aggrieved against the same, respondent preferred revision before the learned Sessions Judge, Rewari. Simultaneously, petitioner also preferred revision against non-summoning of other family members. However, vide order dated 06.04.2017, revision of the respondent was accepted by learned Sessions Judge, Rewari and the revision of petitioner/complainant was dismissed. Both the parties were directed to

appear before the learned trial Court on 15.04.2017 for necessary proceedings and thereafter, learned trial Court was to pass a fresh order in accordance with the observations of the revisional Court with regard to non-maintainability of the complaint as such and also on merits.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed in the matter and the present petition is dismissed as such.
