The present petition has been filed under Section 438 the Cr.P.C seeking anticipatory bail in cross case registered on the basis of DDR No.36 dated 29.03.2017 under Sections 452, 427, 323 and 148 read with Section 149 IPC at Police Station Samalsar, District Moga in FIR No.31 dated 29.03.2017 registered under Sections 324, 323 and 148 read with Section 149 IPC.

On 08.05.2017 this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that no injury has been attributed to the petitioner. The petitioner has been roped in the present FIR only on the ground that he removed injured Chamkaur Singh to hospital.

Notice of motion for 06.07.2017.

The petitioner is directed to join the investigation.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest of the petitioner by the Arresting Officer, he shall be released on interim bail subject to the following conditions:-

1. That he shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;
2. That he shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer and;
3. That he shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court.

It is contended that in pursuance of the order dated 08.05.2017, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of above, the order dated 08.05.2017 passed by this Court is made absolute, subject to furnishing of bail-bonds/surety bonds by the petitioner to the satisfaction of the CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The petition stands allowed.
