The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. praying for issuance of directions to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner by voicing an apprehension and threat to the same at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 7.

Counsel would submit that respondent No.4, namely, Sandeep Kaur is a widow lady with children. At an earlier point of time, respondents No.5 and 6, who are the parents of respondent No.4 had held out an assurance of marrying respondent No.4 with the petitioner and on such assurance, the petitioner had been supporting the family of the private respondents financially. Further submitted that now respondents No.5 and 6 want to marry their daughter somewhere else and in spite of such changed circumstances, money is sought to be extracted and the petitioner is being threatened repeatedly.

Having heard counsel for the petitioner at length and having perused the pleadings on record, this Court finds that there would be no basis to entertain the prayer made in the petition.

The averments made in the petition are utterly vague. There would be no basis for this Court to infer any harassment or threat perception to the petitioner at the hands of the private respondents.

Pleadings on record would not justify any intervention in the matter.

Petition is dismissed.
