By filing the present petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought regular bail in FIR No.178 dated 25.11.2016, registered under Sections 302, 148 read with Section 149 of IPC and Sections 25 & 27 of Arms Act, at Police Station Sadar, Tarn Taran.

It is contended that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case. The challan stands presented. The petitioner is in custody since 26.11.2016. The trial is not likely to be concluded in the near future.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel opposes the

bail application.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

As per FIR, the petitioner was armed with .12 bore double barrel gun; two gun shots injuries have been attributed to the petitioner. The deceased Angrej Singh who had performed love marriage with sister of the petitioner was son of the complainant, Balwinder Singh. The recovery of the weapon of offence was effected in pursuance of the statement made by the petitioner. The empties collected from the spot corroborate the use of weapon held by the petitioner. Keeping in view the fact that it is a case of honour killing and the manner in which brutal killing was executed, this Court is not inclined to accept the prayer made in the present petition.

Dismissed.
