Petitioners feel reasonable apprehension in respect of their lives and personal liberties likely to be violated by respondents No.4 to 6.

As per pleadings, petitioner No.2 is aged 17 and half years at the time of alleged marriage between them on 04.05.2017.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Shilesh Gupta, Addl, AG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3-State.

At this stage, without embarking upon merits of the case, respondent No.2 can be directed to look into the grievance of the petitioners, which has been espoused by them by way of making a representation dated 04.05.2017.

At this stage, validity of the marriage and the age of respondent No.2 cannot be commented upon by this Court. Respondent No.2 would consider the threat perception of the petitioners and pass appropriate order on the pending representation at the earliest in accordance with law.
