INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner-Birender @ Billu has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.94 dated 14.08.2016, registered at Police Station Rohrai, District Rewari, under Sections 148, 149, 302 and 323 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

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From the record, I find that the present petitioner is named in the FIR. The injuries were given to deceased-Inderjeet by the accused. Inderjeet, who suffered the injuries on the throat and other parts of the body, died due to the injuries. Challan has already been presented. However, no witness has been recorded so far. The case is at the preliminary stage.

Keeping in view the nature and gravity of the offence and in view of the facts that the petitioner is named in the FIR and active role has been attributed to him, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of regular bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
