Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are allegedly being harassed at the hands of respondents no.3 and 4 without any case having been registered against any of them, with petitioner no.1 in fact being a widowed lady.

He submits that a representation has been filed by the petitioners to respondent no.2, i.e. the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, and at this stage, he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the said officer to decide the representations of the petitioners within a stipulated period of time.

Consequently, without commenting upon the contentions raised before this Court, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.2, i.e. the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, to go into the matter and take action as is warranted as per law, within a period of one month from the date of the receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Obviously, the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, would also
look into the fact that petitioner no.1 is stated to be a 60 year old lady.
