Petitioner is seeking concession of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.82, dated 15.10.2016 , under Sections 307, 458, 247, 382, 148, 149, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station City Raikot, Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per allegations in the FIR, there was a dispute regarding an agreement between the complainant and co-accused Inderjeet Kaur @ Rani, Yash Pal @ Bittu, Monika Verma @ Ricky and Rishi. Learned counsel further submits that he has no concern with property dispute between the complainant and the co-accused and his name was not mentioned in the FIR. Learned counsel for the petitioner further referred to the allegations where the grievous injuries on the head of the complainant was caused by co-accused Rup @ Cheema. It is further submitted that the petitioner is in judicial custody since 31 October, 2016 and the conclusion of the trial will take long time.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Lakhbir Singh, submits that the petitioner has already undergone an actual period of about 8 months and 20 days and he is not involved in any other case.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner be enlarged on regular bail subject to his furnishing bail / surety bond to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ludhiana.
