Petitioner-Amrit Pal Singh has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for brevity, 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.63 dated 15.04.2017, registered at Police Station Dehlon, District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana, under Section 306 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and complainant also appeared through his counsel. They contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

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From the record, I find that father of the complainant sold paddy crop to Naveen Vadhera @ Kala Aartia. His father also took the land measuring 6 acres on lease from Harbhagwan Singh and lease amount of the same is yet to be paid. The present petitioner helped the complainant party to get this land. The main allegation is against Naveen Vadhera @ Kala Aartia that he had not made the payment of amount of paddy crop sold to him. There is general allegation against the present petitioner that he as well as Harbhagwan Singh gave a complaint in the N.R.I.Police Station and also threatened that they will forcibly cut the crop of complainant. The main accused Naveen Vadhera @ Kala Aartia has already been granted anticipatory bail by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Ludhiana.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. It is ordered that in the event of arrest, the petitioner be released on anticipatory bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
