This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.22 dated 08.02.2017, under Sections 363, 366-A, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station, Civil Lines, Batala, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gurmit Singh, does not dispute the contents of statement made by the prosecutrix under Section 164 Cr.P.C., wherein she stated that she had an affair with the petitioner and had accompanied him at the Railway Station. Thereafter, they went to the house of petitioner's sister.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that compromise dated 03.01.2017 (Annexure P-3) has been effected between the parties and on the basis of this compromise, a quashing petition i.e. CRM-M-10334-2017 has been filed, which is pending before this Court for 10.07.2017.

Keeping in view the period of incarceration of the petitioner and

the fact that trial may take some time for its conclusion, this Court feels that

there is no need to detain the petitioner any longer. Accordingly, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be enlarged on regular bail on furnishing of bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gurdaspur.
