This is second petition filed under Section 438 the Cr.P.C seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.392 dated 10.07.2015, registered under Sections 395 and 397 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act at Police Station Hodal, District Palwal.

This is second bail application. The earlier was dismissed on merits vide order dated 14.09.2016. Learned counsel refers to Annexure P-6 dated 25.03.2017 to contend that compromise has been effected between the parties. However, at this stage, the Court is not impressed by the compromise reached between the parties. The petitioner has successfully evaded the process of the Court after registration of the FIR. Keeping in view the conduct of the petitioner, no case for bail is made out.

However, taking into consideration the compromise,
it is ordered that in case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court

within three weeks from today, his bail application be considered and decided expeditiously.

The present petition is disposed of accordingly.
