Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No. 10, dated 06.02.2017, registered under Sections 307, 452 and 34 I.P.C. and under Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Sekhwan, District Batala.

The FIR was registered at the instance of Arwinder Singh with the allegations that on account of his love marriage

with Manpreet Kaur, Chamkaur Singh-petitioner was having grudge against him. The petitioner is also living in the same lane. On 06.02.2017, at about 1:30 p.m., when the complainant was standing at the gate of his house, then Chamkaur Singh-petitioner came there and by taking out his pistol from his waist, tried to fire at the complainant. The complainant went inside his house. The petitioner followed him. He, in order to kill the complainant, fired at him, but pistol did not work and the fire remained a missed fire. The petitioner again repeated the fire, but it also remained a missed fire. On raising alarm, brother and mother of the complainant came from the adjoining rooms and on seeing them, the petitioner fled away from the spot.

Apparently, this is a case of attempted fire of shots and the pistol did not work.

The petitioner is in custody since 06.02.2017.

It would be debatable as to the complicity of accused and veracity of allegations.

In view of above, I deem it appropriate to enlarge the petitioner on regular bail.

In view of above, petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be enlarged on bail, subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds/ surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Nothing expressed hereinabove would be construed to be an expression of any opinion on merits of the case.
