By this petition, filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C, the petitioner seeks the concession of 'regular bail'.

Upon notice being issued to respondent No.2, though the report of the Registry is to the effect that learned counsel for the petitioner did not turn up to collect the dasti notice, however, learned counsel has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.2-Baljit Singh with the said respondent also stated to be present in Court. He has also been identified by ASI Dilbagh Singh of Police Station Harike, Tehsil Patti, District Tarn Taran.

Upon query, respondent No.2, Baljit Singh, submits that he has actually compromised the matter with the petitioner.

Consequently, without making any comment on the actual nature of the allegations for or against the petitioner, he is ordered to be admitted to bail on furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Tarn Taran.
