The petitioner is seeking concession of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.103, dated 09.04.2017, registered under Section 306 IPC at Police Station, City Kapurthala, District Kapurthala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance to the order dated 08.05.2017, the petitioner has joined the investigation and the police has prepared a cancellation report. This fact is not disputed by the learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Jagbir Singh.

Learned counsel appearing for the complainant submits that the deceased was maltreated at the instance of the petitioner.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and a cancellation report has been prepared, it will be open to the complainant to file a protest petition against the cancellation report qua petitioner herein.

This petition is disposed of. The order dated 08.05.2017 is made absolute.
