Allegedly, as contended before this Court, the petitioner has been evicted from the official accommodation in the Police Lines, Ludhiana, by respondents no.4 to 6, respondent no.6 being his wife, with whom the petitioner has a matrimonial dispute, respondent no.4 being the father of respondent no.6 and respondent no.5 being her brother.

A representation is also stated to have been made to the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana (respondent no.3), by the petitioner in that regard, a copy of which has been annexed as Annexure P-1 with the petition.

Consequently, without commenting upon the allegation made in the petition and contention raised before this Court, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.3, i.e. the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, to go into the matter and take action as is warranted as per

law within a period of one month from the date of the receipt of a certified copy of this order.
