Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been made for quashing of F.I.R. No.327 dated 07.06.2013 under Sections 147/149/326 of the Indian Penal Code pertaining to Police Station Manimajra, Chandigarh, on the basis of compromise dated 28.04.2016 (Annexure-P2).

In pursuance of the order dated 24.08.2016 of this Court, the parties appeared before the trial Court on 02.09.2016 to get recorded their statements. Learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Chandigarh has also sent its report vide covering letter No.JMIC-Ahl-2016/398 dated 02.09.2016 which has been duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Chandigarh vide Endorsement No.DSJ-EC-2016/10492 dated 03.09.2016.

According to the report, the Judicial Magistrate is satisfied that the parties have made an amicable settlement and have recorded their statements in the Court without any undue influence, pressure and coercion from any side.

Considering the report of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Chandigarh dated 02.09.2016 and the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, F.I.R. No.327 dated 07.06.2013 under Sections 147/149/326 I.P.C. pertaining to Police Station Manimajra, Chandigarh, is hereby quashed.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
