The petitioners are seeking quashing of FIR No.3 dated 09.04.2016 under Sections 447/511/379/506/34 IPC registered at Police Station N.R.I Bathinda, District Bathinda (Annexure P-1), on the basis of compromise arrived at between the parties.

A co-ordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 08.05.2017 had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court for recording their statements with regard to the veracity of compromise. The Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bathinda, has sent his report dated 14.06.2017, wherein it is stated that in pursuance to the order of this Court, statements of the parties were recorded. As per the statements, compromise has been effected without any fear or undue influence.

In view of the law laid down in "**Narinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab**" **2014 (6) SCC 466**, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed and FIR No.3 dated 09.04.2016 under Sections 447/511/379/506/34 IPC registered at Police Station N.R.I Bathinda, District Bathinda and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioners only.
