SUDIP AHLUWALIA J. (ORAL)

In this petition, the petitioners, who are the accused persons in FIR No.133 dated 12.11.2016 under Section 323/324/365/148/149 IPC of Police Station, Patti, District Tarn Taran, have prayed for quashing of FIR with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2) arrived at between the parties.

Earlier vide order dated 19.01.2017, this Court had referred the parties to the concerned Illaqa Magistrate for the purpose of verifying the factum of compromise relied upon by the petitioners. Report of the Ld. Illaqa Magistrate has since been received alongwith copies of the statements of the parties recorded by him, and from which it transpires that the parties have resolved their dispute by way of amicable settlement.

In view of the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another, 2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543* and *Narinder Singh and Others Vs. State of Punjab and Another, (2014) 6 SCC 466*, this Court is of the opinion that no useful purpose can be served by keeping with the criminal proceedings pending since the victim has himself compromised the dispute with the petitioners/accused persons and has signed the compromise deed and has furnished an affidavit to this effect.

In the circumstances, the present petition is allowed. FIR No.133 dated 12.11.2016 under Section 323/324/365/148/149 IPC of Police Station, Patti, District Tarn Taran (Annexure P-1), with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom is hereby quashed.
