Sanjeev Sharma has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.252 dated 29.12.2010 under Section 498-A, 323, 406 and 506 read with Section 34 IPC registered at Police Station Ladwa, District Kurukshetra and all the consequent proceedings arisen therefrom.

Appellant No.1-Sanjeev Sharma and respondent No.2- Jyoti have amicably compromised their matrimonial dispute. They filed a joint petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act. Their statements in first motion and second motion had been recorded in terms of the compromise entered into between them. A decree of divorce by mutual consent was passed by us today.
