This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C., seeking 'regular bail' to the petitioner, in FIR No.20 dated 23.1.2017, registered for the alleged commission of the offences punishable under Sections 406,420,120-B IPC, at Police Station Bhargo Camp, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that other than a complaint pending against the petitioner for the alleged commission of an offence punishable under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881, there is no other criminal case pending against her, with the trial in the present case being at the first stage.

Without making any comment on the actual merits of the case for or against the petitioner, I consider it appropriate to admit her to bail.

Accordingly, the petition is allowed. The petitioner shall be admitted to bail upon her furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
